

SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Use of School Facilities and Equipment

Regulations - Facilities

For all non-school hour activities, a custodian or other school employee authorized by the Superintendent of Schools must be present. If a lunch room facility is to be used to prepare a meal, a hot lunch cook or other school employee authorized by the Superintendent of Schools must be available.

All such personnel will be paid by the user not exempted by the School Board or designee.

There shall be no alcoholic liquors or beverages brought to or consumed in the buildings or on the grounds.

Smoking will not be allowed in the building.

If facilities are not properly maintained by the group using the facilities, then the cleaning will be done by school employees and the cost thereof will be charged to the group using the facilities.

School personnel assigned to supervise the building for non-school activities may be requested to perform special school jobs if the activities of the non-school groups do not require attention full time.
