

SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Use of School Facilities and Equipment

Fee Regulations

The Board of Directors directs the Superintendent of Schools to prepare a schedule of fees for the use of school facilities. This schedule shall be presented to the Board of Directors for final approval. The schedule of fees will be reviewed and changed at times to be kept in compliance with current conditions. Rental of school equipment will be at a rate of 1% of the current retail value of the equipment rented. The current retail value will be determined annually on July 1.

The fees as currently in effect shall be: 4-H, Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, and similar organizations which are composed entirely, or principally of students from the Anita Community School District may use the facilities for their meetings at no charge under the following conditions:

1. The meeting is limited to the local organization members only.
2. Adequate adult supervision is available.
3. No extra janitorial fees be incurred. This means the meeting is held during hours the janitor is regularly on duty and any clean-up is done by the organization and its leader.

School connected organizations such as Band Boosters, Athletic Boosters, and PTA groups shall use the facilities without charge for their school connected activities as well as their regularly scheduled meetings.

Any meeting for the betterment of the entire community sponsored by a service organization may use the facilities free under the following conditions:

1. A school employee, or school connected personnel such as board members, authorized by the Superintendent of School is present.
2. It is strictly a meeting with no admission charged.
3. There are no janitorial or other charges resulting from this meeting.

Any meeting of an adult education class sponsored by the local district or jointly sponsored by the local district and some other agency may use the facilities without charge provided an individual acceptable to the Superintendent of Schools is in charge of the class and can see to the locking of the building if necessary.

All other non-profit meetings, including youth activities not covered above shall be subject to a fee by the Anita Board of Education.

Any commercial endeavor which may wish to rent a school facility for a commercial venture must first present its case to the Board of Education for a decision and a setting of a fee.

It is foreseen that there will be unusual circumstances which will arise from time to time which are not covered by the above item and will need to be dealt with on an individual basis. This power is reserved to the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools.
