Conflict of Interest

Board members must be able to make decisions objectively. It shall be a conflict of interest for a board member to receive direct compensation from the school district for anything other than the actual and necessary expenses, including travel, incurred in the performance of official duties. The payment of compensation to any other family member shall be within the discretion of the board.

It shall be the responsibility of each board member to be aware of potential conflicts of this nature, and to take the action necessary to eliminate such a conflict of interest should it arise.
