

STUDENT PERSONNEL

Resident Students

Resident students are those whose legal residence is within the boundaries of the district. Moving into the district for the sole purpose of attending school shall not be considered sufficient evidence of residency. A student unmarried and under eighteen years of age will be considered to have the same legal residence as that of his/her parents or his/her legal guardian.

Students for whom there may be some question of residence in the district, and who wish to apply for enrollment on a tuition-free basis, shall provide such evidence as requested by the superintendent or his/her designee. The superintendent shall examine all the evidence available to him/her and decide whether the student qualifies as a resident of the district.
