Programs of Instruction

Elementary Curriculum

The program of instruction in the regular elementary schools shall include: (a) the language arts; including reading, writing, spelling, and oral and written expression, (b) the social studies; including U.S. and State history, geography, and civics, (c) arithmetic, (d) science, (e) physical education, (f) health, (g) music, (h) arts and crafts and (i) technology. Each of these subject fields shall insofar as practicable promote in the materials used, and in the teaching procedures employed, instruction in study and work habits, library usage, safety, thrift, conservation, health and hygiene, citizenship, the establishment of goals, and the development of character and morality. Provision shall be made for the inculcation of ideals of group and individual behavior, and to this end, organized play, intramural sports and games, hobby groups, and other organized student activities shall be fostered.

In all instances, the elementary curriculum shall meet the minimum educational requirements established by state statute and the State Department of Public Instruction.
