Special Education-Procedural Safeguards

The Board of Education recognizes that parents and their handicapped children have certain rights which are protected under Public Law 94-142 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Among these are the rights 1) to a free and appropriate education, 2) to be notified of the existence of, 3) to have written notice of plans to identify, evaluate or place a child, 4) to consent or withhold consent to allow identification, evaluation or placement of a child, 5) to an impartial due process hearing, 6) to a surrogate parent when necessary, 7) to a multidisciplinary evaluation and 8) to confidentiality.

The Procedural Safeguards and Due Process Procedure shall constitute the guidelines to be followed by this district in protecting the rights of parents and handicapped pupils.
