Disposition of Obsolete Equipment

It is recommended that whenever any furnishings, equipment, and/or supplies valued at less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) have been declared obsolete by the administration, the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designated agent shall be authorized to dispose of such furnishings, equipment, and/or supplies at the best price possible. The funds derived therefore shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the Board. The Secretary of the Board shall credit such receipts to the proper fund as stated in Code of Iowa, Chapter 297.22.

Whenever any furnishings, equipment, and/or supplies valued at more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) have been declared obsolete by the administration, the Superintendent of Schools shall sell such items under the Code of Iowa, Chapter 297.15 through 297.25.
