

CAM District Wide Procedures



School Year:

- Students will attend in person starting August 23rd
- CAM Community School District will continue to consult Cass County Health Services, statewide information, to monitor case activity, and protocols regarding positive cases.
- Students who must be quarantined will have the opportunity to complete work during their quarantine period online, or alternate means.

Masks:

- Masks or face coverings are not required for staff, students or visitors, yet are encouraged to wear by the CDC if not vaccinated.

Mitigation and Hygiene:

- Desks and surfaces will be sanitized daily.
- Hand sanitizing and hand washing will be encouraged by staff and students.
- Drinking fountains will be available and sanitized during the school day.

In the event of illness:

- Students or staff exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID19 will be strongly encouraged to be tested or quarantined as directed by Cass County Health Services.
- A student or staff member should be fever free (without medication) or vomit free for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Students staying home sick have access to curriculum online or by other means.

Protocol:

- Visitors will have normal access to the buildings.
- All visitors are required to check into the building office.
- Drop and pick up schedules will be communicated by individual buildings.
