The Last will and testament of Alice Graham, deceased, established a trust fund and the income there from is to be used for the purpose of defraying the expenses of one or more young men and women who are residents of Pottawattamie County or Cass County while attending college of university in the State of Iowa.

As a means of determining the young men or women who shall have the benefits of said scholarships, the Will provides that a competitive examination be given and made open to all Protestant graduates of any high school in Pottawattamie County or Cass County within two (2) years immediately preceding examination and who are of good moral character. Applicants scoring the highest general average on the test will receive a scholarship which will be paid at the rate of \$500.00 per year for four terms, unless a year of college has already been completed, in which case the scholarship shall be three (3) year term. The scholarship may be used toward paying tuition, board, lodging, travel expenses and any other necessary expenses while attending the school.
